1. NT is ≥ 3.5 mm AND one of the following ultrasound anomalies is present:

- distended jugular lymphatic sacs
- hydrops fetalis
- pleural effusion
- ascites
- cardiac anomalies
- renal anomalies
- polyhydramnios

OR

2. isolated increased NT of ≥ 5.0 mm.
